## Exim Configuration

- Single master configuration file: /usr/local/etc/exim/configure (FreeBSD port) /usr/exim/configure (if installing from source)
- Controls the decision-making and delivery process:
  - Very flexible expression language
  - Can be configured to look up data in external tables or databases
- Basic default configuration:

/etc/aliases, .forward, mbox delivery for system accounts, relaying control

## Changing the configuration

- Test it after making changes:
  - if you wish, can prepare a new file and test it with

```
exim -C configfile ....
```

- You need to "HUP" the exim daemon to make it re-read its config file:
  - · cat /var/run/exim.pid
  - send this process a "HUP" signal
  - kill -1 n
  - or: kill -HUP *n* (same thing)
