What is a NOC?

- Usually the first point-of-contact for other network operators
- Monitors all production systems
- Usually work longer hours than normal, often in shifts (many are 24 hours)
- Often does other things that need to happen after-hours

What is a NOC?

- In case of trouble, the NOC's job is to coordinate repair efforts
- Often, if customers have service-level agreements or other guarantees, the NOC's logs are what are used to make reports about outages

NOC Tools

- mrtg, cricket, things that measure counters
- **nfsen**, or other things that measure traffic
- rt3, or some other ticket system
- syslogd, or some other log collection tool
- rancid, to monitor configuration changes
- smokeping, to find latency problems
